***Happy Spring Beautiful Residents!*** Here is some helpful information on obtaining vaccination transportation and mobile vaccination for seniors:

### COVID-19 Vaccine Transportation

**Seniors** who are unable to find transportation to the Orange County Convention Center vaccination site may be able to qualify for a free ride, thanks to LYNX.

Eligible residents must:

- Be 65+ and older
- Already obtained an appointment for a vaccine at the Orange County Convention Center
- Not have a way to transport themselves to the Convention Center

If you meet these criteria, **call the County's helpline at 311 (or 407-836-3111 if out of county) for details/coordination.** Scheduling transportation needs to be made 24 hours in advance, before 5 p.m.

### Mobile COVID-19 Vaccines

Homebound Seniors can register to have the COVID-19 vaccine brought directly to their home.

## **Get Healthy: Do-It-Yourself Multipurpose Cleaner**

Combine in a spray bottle

2 quarts water

1 teaspoon Dawn liquid dish soap OR ½ cup ammonia

¼ cup vinegar

¼ cup baking soda.

1. Pour toilet bowl cleaner into your toilet before you go to bed at night making it simple to clean and flush the next morning.
2. Clean up messes as they come to prevent an overwhelming cleaning job later. Toothpaste is easy to remove right after it lands in the sink. A spill on the counter is much easier to clean before it's allowed to harden.
3. Use a lightweight stick vacuum for dry cleanups.
